

National Hypnotherapy Society’s Terms and Conditions for Training Providers

1. The training provider agrees to abide by the National Hypnotherapy Society’s (HS/Society) Code of Ethics and Complaints Procedure, details of which are available online or through the Society’s office.
2. The training provider accepts the provisions of the National Hypnotherapy Society’s Constitution.
3. The training provider confirms that they either own, or have permission to use, all content contained within and/or issued as part of the recognised course.
4. The training provider agrees to the following renewal/reaccreditation conditions:
 - a. Complete the renewal form sent to them each year and ensure the renewal payment is made on time
 - b. Encourage all students and graduates on the HS accredited course to join the Society
 - c. Provide all students and graduates on the HS accredited course with Society application forms, materials and share information from the Society with them
 - d. Always keep the Society up to date with any changes to contact details and course amendments
5. Course accreditation is conditional on the course being actively run and the course provider encouraging students and graduates to join the Society. In circumstances where there is insufficient participation in the Society by students and graduates, course accreditation or approval may be withdrawn with sufficient notice given by the Society.
6. The training provider understands that course accreditation is at the discretion of the Society and is subject to random auditing and renewal processes.
7. The training provider agrees to display the provided HS accredited course logo on their website and promotional material i.e. brochure, by following the instructions for use below:
8. The training provider can only use the logo by clearly indicating the course which is accredited by using the words “(course) is accredited by the National Hypnotherapy Society and, at the discretion of the Society, is a route onto a register of hypnotherapists which is accredited by the Professional Standards Authority”. The provider cannot use the logo in any way which gives the impression that (a) it is the training provider rather than the course which is accredited or (b) that any other non-accredited course is accredited.
9. The training provider is not permitted to display the logo before being given permission to do so by the National Hypnotherapy Society.
10. The training provider must only use the logo that is provided by the National Hypnotherapy Society and must not alter it in any way, shape or form.
11. The training provider must follow any instruction from the National Hypnotherapy Society, regarding updates to the logo.
12. The National Hypnotherapy Society will monitor the logo for proper use and reserves the right to query or withdraw the use of the logo from any training provider.
13. If course accreditation ceases between the training provider and the National Hypnotherapy Society then the logo must be removed from all website and promotional materials within 14 days of expiration of accreditation.
14. The National Hypnotherapy Society reserves the right to request a removal of the logo from the training provider’s website, if it has been deemed as being used inappropriately or not in accordance with these terms and conditions.
15. The training provider is not permitted to mislead anyone as to what the accreditation means.
16. The training provider is not to claim that their training is endorsed by the Professional Standards Authority or by the government.
